New Maths Curriculum for 2025

The announcement from the Prime Minister last week about the release of a new math curriculum for the start of the 2025 year was a surprise to many. At this stage the details of how this might look for schools or what will be included in the new curriculum is yet to be shared.

What we know about the changes so far are:


- 1. The implementation of the refreshed math curriculum for years 0-8 is being moved forward by a year to be required in 2025.
- 2. There will be \$20Million of funding for Professional Learning and Development for teachers in structured math.
- 3. New resources aligned to the new curriculum including detailed teacher guides and student workbooks to support the teaching of the new curriculum will be provided to schools.
- 4. Increasing support will be provided for students who fall far behind the curriculum.
- 5. The Teaching Council has agreed the minimum requirement for entry into teaching training courses should be lifted to include 14 NCEA math credits at level 2.

We are keen to see and hear further details about this announcement over the coming few months and will keep you informed as this happens.






